

**OLD ENEMIES, NEW FRIENDS**



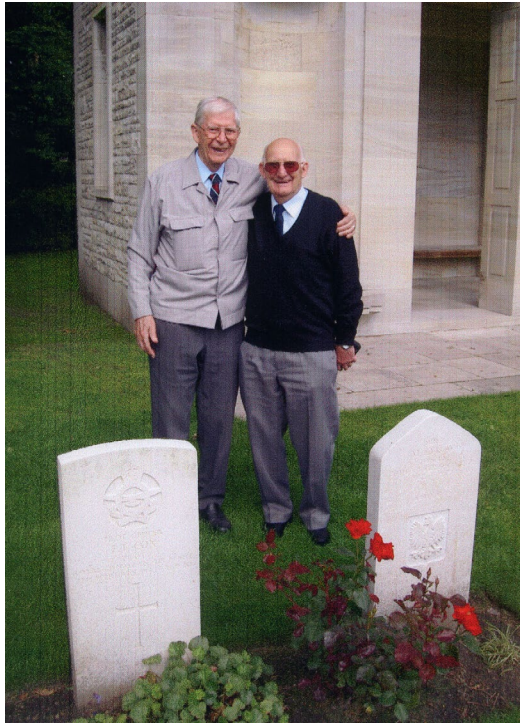
