Notes on Utility Furniture Units

(For Notes on Priority Dockets, please see inside back cover)

1. The utility furniture units in this permit are valid only for six months from the date of issue. Unused units must be returned to the Board of Trade if, after they have been issued, the circumstances of the holder change so that he no longer needs furniture for the reasons he gave on his application form.
2. The name of the person to whom this permit is issued is entered on the front cover and the permit may only be used by or on behalf of that person. Before using the permit, he should enter on the front cover also his address and either his National Registration (Identity Card) Number or his Service Number and Rank.
3. When shopping you must hand the permit complete with the utility furniture units to the shopkeeper. If there are more units than he needs for your order, he will cut out the number required and return the rest to you. You must not cut units out yourself and it is illegal for the shopkeeper to accept loose units.
4. The shopkeeper may not retain units except when an order has been placed.
5. When ordering goods by post, send the permit complete with the utility furniture units. If there are more units included in the permit than are needed for your order, the shopkeeper will return the permit together with the surplus units.

Notes on Priority Dockets

In Notes on Utility Furniture Units, please see inside of (front cover)

If you have applied for and are entitled to Priority Dockets for certain riot, floor covering, mattresses, blankets or sheets, you will find them fastened in book. Before using them, you must write your name and address in the space provided on the back of each. If you receive a Priority Docket for curtain cloth, you must also write your name and address on the back of the Certificate tied to the Docket.

There is no time limit for Priority Dockets and they can be used at any time which regularly sells the type of goods concerned. There is no need to keep Dockets fixed in the book; you may take them out and hand them to the keeper separately if you wish. You will find further information about them in leaflet (U.F.D.16) which accompanies this permit and you should read fully the notes printed on the dockets themselves.

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NOTES

P TO CONSUMER. You must enter your name and address in the space provided. *My name is Margaret J. Evans. 51. York St. Glasgow.*
and give the docket to your supplier. You will then get priority in obtaining supplies.

P TO TRADER. By posting this docket back to your supplier with your order, and any coupons that may be necessary, you will be able to obtain replacement of the goods sold against it. If you do not wish to replace the goods you should return the docket to the Assistant Chief Assistant, Buying Permit Section, Board of Trade, S.M.C., North Gate, Palace Avenue Road, Leamington, N.W.I.

Instructions on the front of panel of Dockets which are posted back will be given through their trade organisation to the holders of special stocks reserved against Priority Dockets.

P TO CONSUMER. This docket has no coupon value. See **P AND TRADER.** overleaf for instructions about national goods.
