



#### GENERAL INFERENCE

A deep depression off West Iceland is moving northeast and a secondary trough is approaching our northwest coasts. A small depression east of the Azores will move northeast and affect Southern England later tomorrow. There will be occasional heavy rain and feeble local thunder over a large area in the Northwest, but bright intervals later. Rainfall will be much less in eastern districts and it may not reach the extreme Southeast before noon to-morrow.

#### FURTHER OUTLOOK

Rain probable over a considerable part of England. Fair in northwestern districts except for showers near western coasts.
