The General Conditions of the Contract of Enlistment that you are about to enter into with the Crown are as follows:—

You will engage to serve His Majouty as an airman for a period of a years Regular Air Perce Service, provided His Majouty should so long require your services, with the additional liabilities specified in Question 23 on pages of this Form. Permission to extend this period of regular service or to re-engage to complete time for pension are privileges which can only be accorded to a proportion of airmen who are recommended by their formanding Officer and who are accepted for extension or e-engagement by a completed authority.

 On callistment into the Royal Air Force, you will be liable, if medically fit, to carry out duty in the air in any type of aircraft and may be ordered to serve in any part of the world, ashore or affoat.
 Your term of Service will be reakoned thus:—
