## INFORMATION

This book may be used at any of the 15,000 Post Offices in Great Britain and Northern Ireland at which Savings Bank business is transacted. Every transaction is reported to the Chief Office of the Savings Bank, where all the accounts are kept. The Bank is associated with the National Savings Movement.

**DEPOSITS.**—Provided not less than 1s. is received, cash, cheques, savings stamps from stamp savings books, money and postal orders, etc., may be deposited. There is no usual limit to the amount that may be held in an account, but not more than £500 may be deposited in a calendar year. Deposits of £50 or more are acknowledged. Deposits may be made for children under seven, and societies and clubs may have accounts.

**WITHDRAWALS.**—Up to £5 on demand at a Post Office. Any larger amount by notice to the Chief Office, sums up to £10 being normally payable the day after receipt of the application and larger sums one day later. Withdrawals may also be made by telegraph. Four working days (eight days in the case of a cheque) must elapse before a deposit is withdrawn.

**INTEREST.**—2½% or 3½% per £1 per complete calendar month, added to the principal at the 31st December.

**BANK BOOK.**—The book should be sent to the Chief Office for mark on the anniversary of the opening of the account, unless interest for the previous year has already been entered. An envelope for the purpose may be obtained at a Post Office. Covers of the Book should be certified to the Chief Office immediately. The book should not be left at a Post Office for safe keeping.

**INVESTMENTS.**—Facilities are offered for investment in Government Bonds and for the purchase of Government Annuities.

**NOMINATIONS.**—A depositor desiring to nominate a person to receive money due at his or her death should apply to the Chief Office.
