NOTICE to be given to a Man at the time of his offering to join The Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

Date..... *1st May* ..... 1941

The General Conditions of the Contract of Enlistment that you are about to enter into with the Crown are as follows:—

1. You will engage to serve His Majesty as an airman for the duration of the present Emergency, provided His Majesty should so long require your services.

2. On enlistment into the Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve, you will be liable, if medically fit, to carry out duty in the air in any type of aircraft and may be ordered to serve in any part of the world, ashore or afloat.

3. Your term of Service shall begin to reckon from the date of Attestation.

4. The age given by you on enlistment will be accepted as your true age, and you will be liable to be held to serve on the engagement for which you attest notwithstanding that at some future date you may prove that your age given on enlistment is incorrect.

5. Men in receipt of a disability pension are not eligible for enlistment.

6. You will be attested by the Attesting Officer. On completion of your attestation you will be subject to all the provisions of the Air Force Act for the time being in force.

7. You will be required by the Attesting Officer to answer the questions printed on pages 2 and 3, to take the oath shown on page 4, and you are warned that if at the time of your attestation you wilfully or knowingly make any false answer to him you will thereby render yourself liable under the Air Force Act to a maximum punishment of two years' imprisonment with hard labour.

8. If, after arrival at the R.A.F. Recruits Centre, you refuse to enlist for personal reasons, you must be prepared to make your own arrangements for your return journey home. No undertaking can be given that a free warrant would be issued to you.

### Questions to be put to the Recruit before Enlistment.

Every Recruit warned that if, after enlistment, it is found that you have wilfully or knowingly made a false answer to any of the following questions, or if you have at any time been discharged with disgrace from any of His Majesty's Air or Maritime Forces or dismissed with disgrace from the Navy and have failed to declare such discharge or dismissal, you will be liable under the Air Force Act to a sentence in punishment of two years' imprisonment, with hard labour.

For the duration of the present Emergency, which means that you will be required to help in His Majesty's efforts to equip your services in connection with the Emergency for which you are now enlisted, and that if you are still serving at the termination of the Emergency you will be discharged at once if your services are no longer required.

19. Section 1. (FOR A RECRUIT BEING ENLISTED AS AN AIRCRAFTSMAN FOR TRAINING IN A TRADE OR AS A MEDICAL ORIGINALLY UNDER TRAINING.)
