## CONDITIONS OF ISSUE

1. This identity card is an official document and is issued subject to the conditions hereon and to the penalties and provisions of Section I of the Official Secrets Act 1920, and of the Defence Regulations, Its alteration, defacement, irregular use, transfer to another person, impersonation of the authorised hoider, loss by neglect, destruction unauthorised retention, are penal offences.

2. This card relates only to the identity of the person described. It is not available as a passport, pass or permit, except as officially authorised by the Air-Ministry, Provost Marshal, R.A.F.

3. This card must be carried by the holder at all times. It is to be presented for inspection on the demand of a member of his Majesty's or Allied Armed Forces in uniform and on duty, or a policeman, or an official on duty at Protected Places or Areas.

4. The holder of this card is personally responsible for taking all possible precautions against its loss, theft or damage. The card must be kept clean and it must not be folded.

5. The holder of this card is to report its loss without delay to his (or her) C.O.

6. On change of rank or appointment to a commission, the holder is to submit this card for endorsement to his (or her) C.O. or another officer to whom the duties have been delegated.

7. This identity card must be returned by the holder to his (or her) C.O. on demand or without demand on ceasing to be a member of the Service.

If this card is found it should be delivered without delay to the nearest Air Force or Police authority.
