- Uniform and personal kit will be issued to you after joining H.M. Forces. Any kit that you take with you should not exceed 15 lbs, in total weight and should be limited to an overcost, change of underclothes, stout pair of boots, and personal kit, such as hair-brush, tooth-brush, soap and towel.
- 3. If you are a member of the Home Guard you must :-
 - Immediately report to your Section, Platoon or Company Commander that you have received an enlistment notice.
 - (2) Before you leave to join your Unit, hand in to your Home Guard Commander everything in your possession issued from Home Guard sources (except Mk. III Respirator Spectacles, if these have been supplied). Failure to comply with this may result in your being called upon to pay for deficiencies.
 - (3) If you have been issued with a pair of Mk. HI Respirator Spectacles, you should take them with you and report the fact to the Unit you join.
- 4.
