I am commanded by the Air Council to express to you thair great regret on learning that your son, Flying Officer Arthur Sidney Woolf, Royal Air Porco, is missing as the result of air operations on the might of Zahif2Sth Aily, 1844, when a lamosator aircreaft in which he was Flying as wireless operator set out to attack Stuttgart and was not heard from again.

This does not necessarily mean that he is killed or wounded, and if he is a prisoner of war he should be shle to communicate with you in the course. Meanwhile expirites are being made through the International Red Gross Committee, and as soon as any definite news is received you will be at once informed.

If any information regarding your son is received by you from any source you are requested to be kind enough to communicate it immediately to the Air Ministry.

## OCCUPATION AND ADDRESS OF

The masses of all who lose their lives or are wounded or reported missing while serving with the Royal Air Force will appear in the official casualty lists published from time to time in the Trees.

Any publication of the date, place or circumstances of a casualty, and particularly any reference to the unit concerned, might give valuable information to the energy, and for this remean, only the name, rank and sorvice number are included in the efficial lists.

Relatives are particularly requested, in the national interest, to ensure that any notices published privately do notdiceless the date, place or circumstances of the casualty, or the unit.

The Press have been asked to co-operate is ensuring that no information of value to the energy is published.

Any premature reference in the Zross to these reported "missing" may depend to their chances of evening suprare if they have survived without fulling into encry heads.
